These celebrities have all generously donated their hair to The Little Princess Trust for children and teens suffering from hair loss.

The Little Princess Trust is the only UK charity to supply real hair wigs free of charge for children undergoing cancer. The charity has supplied almost 5,000 wigs over the last ten years and is still helping children today.

The charity is based in Hereford and was started in 2006 in memory of 5 year-old Hannah Tarplee, who sadly lost her own battle with cancer the previous year.



The charity has been going for over 10 years and has grown massively throughout that time. Wendy, the co-owner of The Little Princess Trust, said that it all started from her daughter's school, for raised money for Hannah and then more and more donations came in so she decided to make a charity where she could supply free wigs for people who have lost their hair.

The Little Princess Trust supply real hair wigs for children age 2-18(24) for children that have lost their hair due to treatment. The hair donations received from people from around the world are made into real hair wigs and are given to children free of charge.

Wendy Tarplee also said: "I think it's important for children suffering with hair loss to be provided with a wig because it is a big shock to lose your hair. It makes it obvious that there is something wrong with them and it makes them feel self-conscious. It's a little piece of them that they'd like to have back to have their identity and it is one thing that we can help give them back."
